

COVID-19 GUIDANCE



ARRIVING AT THE STUDIO

To ensure all personnel gain access safely when arriving you should:

- Allow for extra time accessing the studio.
- Rehearsal and recording sessions have been staggered to allow for safe arrival and exit to and from the building.
- Use the sanitising stations situated at the entrances.
- On entry proceed directly to your designated location/room and remain at this location as much as possible.

SOCIAL-DISTANCING

To reduce the possibility of transmission on-site we are implementing:

- A one way system of entering and leaving the building so please enter via the double at the front of the building and leaving via the double doors in the vestibule.
- A protective screen is installed on the main reception desk.
- Social distance signage installed in corridors and stairwells as appropriate.
- Restricted movement between the control room and live venue, this is clearly marked out on the floors.

PERSONAL HYGIENE

To reduce the possibility of transmission on-site we are providing:

- Sanitising stations and signage at external entry and studio entry points.
- Advisory / guidance hand wash signage in all bathrooms
- PPE
- Specific PPE is not mandatory for attending the studio; however we do ask that musicians use face coverings or masks as much as possible when not playing.

Eiger staff will be supplied with, situation appropriate, PPE. Bands and musicians should supply their own face coverings or PPE, however we do have some available at the main desk.

COVID-19 SPECIFIC CLEANING

To remove possible contamination of surfaces and equipment we will:

- Disinfect common touch areas, in the morning & throughout the day after session breaks.
- Perform deep cleaning of the studio and rehearsal rooms on a regular basis.
- Specific cleaning of musician equipment: chairs, headphones, drum shells, amps, music stands, microphones etc.

WHAT WE EXPECT FROM YOU

- Maintain social distancing wherever possible, including while arriving at and departing from the studio as well as rehearsing.
- Bring your own instruments and breakables where if possible to avoid cross contamination.
- Practicing and performing safely in rooms and not posting any images and videos clearly showing a lack of social distancing on the premises.
